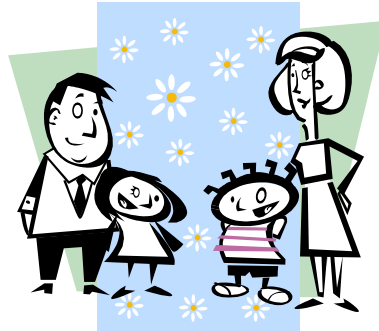

The play area/ picnic area is due to be cleared and re fenced and the gate re-hung very soon so your children have a safe area to play in,

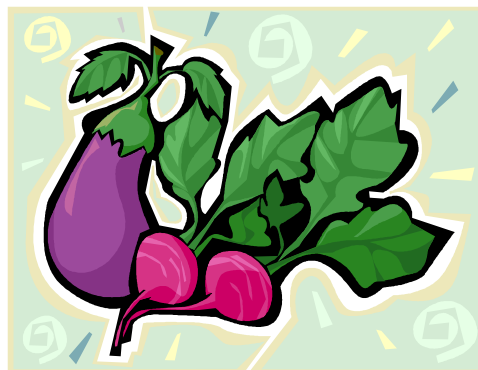
Parents are responsible for their children's safety on site but drivers are reminded to keep speed down to 10 mph or under.
