To help you along.....

Our Brook Road Show this year is not a formal flower show so you can bring any vegetables along, but please make sure your vegetables are clean with no soil or mud attached, before you go into the exhibition tent. (This will help keep our tables clean!!!!) (A small help note, Where a class requests an exact number of items then the group of vegetables presented should be as near identical in size as possible.)

You can bring your entries in from 2.30 till 6.30 on the Saturday (careful with 'Wilting' Vegetables) and from 10.00 until noon on the Sunday.

Report to the tent entry desk, and you will be given a reference number for each of your entries.

Then go to the exhibit tables appropriate to the class and lay out your entry with reference number card laid face down on, or very close to your entry, you can place your vegetable exhibits on a plastic plate if required, (available from the entry desk).

The show assistant will be pleased to advise you on this and on the location of the exhibits, and setting of the numbers adjacent to the exhibit, in order that judging can be carried out.

Once you are happy with the layout of your entry please leave the tent.

Judging will be carried out at about 12.30, on the Sunday

A local councillor or personality will carry out the Judging

The Judges decision is final and neither the committee nor Judge will enter into discussion regarding the final outcome of each class.

WINNERS

- 1) Each vegetable class winner will be presented with a souvenir winner's card, and a packet(s) of seeds for the class for next years crop.
- 2) In the Children's classes each entry will receive a prize for entering and the winners will each receive a prize
- 3) The Kitchen produce winner and best in show will also receive an appropriate prizes.
